Step 1

Register

1. Logon using this link, <http://www.nuigalway.ie/registration>.
2. Enter your User Name (ID number) and password.
User name: Your NUIG student number e.g. 15100001
Password: Your existing password*
*(*If you are having difficulty accessing your student account, please see point 3, CASS account below for information)*
3. Update your personal details e.g. term address, mobile number only under the 'Profile' tab
4. To proceed, click on the 'Courses' tab at the top of the page
5. To confirm your registration, click 'Register' on the right hand side of the screen under the 'Courses' tab, the Academic year must read 2016
6. Read the Terms & Conditions and if you agree tick the check box and 'Continue'
7. Update any other personal details and hit 'Continue'
8. YOU CAN OPT TO PAY FEES NOW OR PAY LATER, any fee queries should be directed to fees@nuigalway.ie*
9. You are now registered!
10. You can 'Print' this screen, 'Finish' and exit the page or 'Continue' to select your subjects/modules (where relevant)
11. Select your subjects / modules (where relevant) and follow the prompts provided
