

Diploma in Italian: Online Intermediate, Year 1

This course caters for students who have already obtained a Level A2 of fluency in Italian and wish progress towards level B2. The course focuses on the four main language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) using regular practice based, as much as possible, on authentic material carefully selected to guide students towards the acquisition of more advanced structures and functions of the language.

A cultural module will present aspects of Italian culture and society from both a linguistic and intercultural perspective, introducing texts and personalities from Italian arts, music, cinema, literature and exploring societal issues.

IT8100 Italian Communication Skills 1, Part 1

This module continues to develop the four main language skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) using regular practice based, as much as possible, on authentic material. At the end of the module students will have consolidated and expanded on level A2 of the Common European Framework of Reference and progressed towards level B1.

Assessment: Continuous assessment, oral examination and written examination

Weighting: 5 ECTS
